

Winter Adventure in BC's Powderland



In summer orchards and palms characterize the area around Okanagan Valley but in winter, three different ski areas dominate the region. Enjoy winter wonderland west of Monashee mountain range: powder snow as far as the eye can reach, wonderful ski-runs and bizarre snow formations that change their shape from day to day – the so called snow-ghosts. This is a proof of the huge amount of snow that prevails in this area.

11 days / 10 nights of Fabulous Powder Skiing Adventure

Day 1 – Arrival in Kelowna:

Transfer by shuttle bus or with your rental car from Kelowna airport to Big White, your first ski resort, at 1,755 meters above sea level.

Day 2 & 3 – Skiing in Big White:



Your "Snow-Host" will join you on your first ski runs. Enjoy the Big White ski area with powder snow so light and dry that people call it "Champagne Powder". Then relax and enjoy the

atmosphere at Sam's pub. Or if you prefer a quiet evening, you could curl up by the fire place in your hotel room.

Day 4 – Big White - Silver Star:

After breakfast you go to Silver Star. During the 2.5 hrs drive you can enjoy amazing scenery along Lake Okanagan and Wood Lake. In the afternoon you have free time explore the resort or you could decide to go cross country skiing in the beautiful surroundings. With more than 100 km of cross country ski runs Silver Star is North America's cross country hub.

Day 5 & 6 – Skiing in Silver Star:

You will be spoilt for choice as Silver Star offers 112 different ski runs! Pick out your favourites,



enjoy the excitement of powder and moogles runs and the feeling of freedom far from the crowds.

Day 7 – Silver Star - Sun Peaks:

Your journey continues to the third and last ski area of your Western Canada trip – Sun Peaks.

You will be amazed when you see Sun Peaks because it is a replica of a South Tyrolian village. In the afternoon, there is enough time to do some shopping in town, to go hiking or on a carriage tour. If you want more action, you can decide to go snow-shoeing or snowmobiling.

Day 8 – 10 – Ski fun in Sun Peaks:

Where else would you get an opportunity to check out the ski runs with Nancy Greene, the 1968 Olympic giant slalom winner? If you are lucky, you will find her at the Meeting Point next to the valley station. In Sun Peaks you can start and end skiing right in front of your hotel.



Day 11 – Sun Peaks – Kelowna:

Today is the day to say goodbye. You return to Kelowna airport and continue your way back home... unless you choose to continue your journey from Kelowna to the Rocky Mountains or to add a heliski adventure.
